

Thank you for calling Local 1262's Information Hotline. This is the latest update from President Harvey Wille as of **Friday, October 10, 2025 and contains two brief messages. October is National Breast Cancer Awareness Month and a good reminder to schedule an Annual Breast Exam. One out of eight women have a chance of developing breast cancer (and one out of 800 men) so screening – through monthly self-exams and regular mammograms -- is especially important to catch the disease in its early stages.

According to The American Cancer Society most women should start annual mammographies between the age of 40 and 45, and those with a history of breast cancer in their family should start as early as 30. These are general guidelines, so speak to your doctor for recommendations specific to your needs.

Most health insurance plans cover mammographies. However, if your plan does not cover it or you have no insurance, you can locate free mammography services near you by visiting www.nationalbreastcancer.org.
