Workers at Acme -- and most other supermarkets owned by Albertsons -- are members of the United Food & Commercial Workers Union (UFCW), which represents more than 800,000 grocery workers in the United States and Canada.

Workers at Albertsons' stores in North Texas are currently trying to join the UFCW in order to obtain better pay, scheduling certainty and on-the-job protections that only a union contract can provide. However, Albertsons is undertaking scare tactics at these locations in an attempt to keep the union out. Albertsons is trying to rob these workers of their RIGHT to join a union because they do not think the community is paying attention.

Last week Local 1262 Union Representatives visited Acme locations in Edgewater and Jersey City to distribute petitions to shoppers to show their support for the workers in Texas.

As a union member, you can also show your support by signing the UFCW's Petition so the workers in Texas can exercise their right to join a union and to have a contract that will provide them with good-paying jobs, benefits and job protections just like workers in Acme and other Albertsons stores.
