UFCW Local 1262 and Local 1 met today (Friday, November third) with Wakefern representatives to present our Effects Bargaining Proposals related to the company's closing of five Albany Area ShopRite Stores.

During the meeting, Local 1262 presented our members requests to the Company regarding items such as such as severance pay and health and welfare and retirement benefits.

"Local 1262 has been out in the stores with our members on a daily basis since Wakefern announced the closings," said President Harvey Whille. "We heard their concerns regarding severance and health and welfare benefits and brought them directly to the company at this meeting. We intend to use every mechanism available to us in order to see that these members are treated fairly and with the respect they deserve for their years of service to that company."

He added that both the Locals and the company will review each other's proposals and reconvene early next week. In the meantime, Local 1262 will continue to work with these members on a daily basis.
