UFCW Local 1262 and Local 1 met again today (Thursday, November 9) with Wakefern representatives to review Effects Bargaining Proposals related to the company's closing of five Albany Area ShopRite Stores.

The meeting focused on severance pay and health and welfare and retirement benefits for these members.

"I believe we are close to a final agreement with the company, however there is still work to be done," said Local 1262 President Harvey Whille. "We are working on this situation around the clock and hope to have a final agreement to present to our members early next week."

President Whille added that Local 1262 has been in the affected stores with Local 1262 members on a daily basis since Wakefern announced the closings and that State of New York Rapid Response Team meetings are scheduled to take place in the stores next Thursday and Friday, November 16 and 17. He urged members to check their breakrooms – or our website – for more details on these meetings.
