Local 1262's Annual Scholarship Program is now accepting applications for the 2026 year. Our Scholarship Program is open to Local 1262 members and their dependents and awards ten scholarships each year -- one \$2,500 Memorial Award Scholarship and nine \$1,500 scholarships. To be eligible for a scholarship you must be a Local 1262 member or a dependent or child of a Local 1262 member and a senior in high school or a freshman, sophomore or junior in college. Once we review the Short-Form Application to determine your eligibility we will mail a Long-Form Application to your home. **The deadline for the Long-Form Application and transcripts is Friday, May 15, 2026.**
