Our second message is to announce that Local 1262's Executive Board voted unanimously at their last meeting to endorse Mikie Sherrill in her bid to become the next Governor of New Jersey.

Congresswoman Sherrill met with Local 1262 and other UFCW Locals from New Jersey in June to discuss issues of importance to working families and to answer questions from those in attendance.

"Mikie is, as they say, "the real deal," said President Whille. "We were proud to endorse her in her previous campaigns for Congress. And based on her record of supporting the working class while in Washington, we are proud to endorse her bid for Governor, where she will continue to fight for New Jersey's working families including our 22,000 members.

"I cannot stress enough the importance of being involved in this year's Race for Governor," said Whille. "No matter which candidate you support the only way you can help change things in this state is to make sure you are registered to vote. And then, most importantly, making sure to cast your vote whether that be in person or via Vote By Mail."
