

**Thank you for calling Local 1262's Information Hotline. This is the latest update from President Harvey Whille as of Friday, July 19, 2024 and contains two messages. Local 1262 would like to remind our members who are enrolled in the Defined Contribution Retirement Plan to watch their mail for their Quarterly Account Summary. Local 1262 members who work full-time and were hired after September 2, 2011 and part-time workers hired after October 2, 2010 are eligible for this benefit. You must also be at least 21 years old and have at least one year of service.

Members hired before those dates participate in our Defined Benefit Pension Plan and can obtain a statement on their account by calling the Pension Department.

Because Local 1262 regularly mails these types of notices and other benefit information, it is important that you make sure your union records are up-to-date. Items to consider include a change-of-address, marriages and divorces as well as any change of beneficiaries you may want to make on your union issued life insurance.

Updating this information with your employer does not automatically update your records with Local 1262 or our Health & Welfare Funds.

To update your contact and other information you can call our Records Department Monday to Friday 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. If you are calling from New Jersey dial 1-800-562-6913; if you are calling from another state, dial 1-800-526-7814.
