It was declared a national holiday in 1894 to be observed on the first Monday in September by President Grover Cleveland (who was, by the way, the only President born in New Jersey).

American labor has raised the nation's standard of living by helping establish things that we take for granted today, like the 40-hour work week and Social Security. It is appropriate, therefore, that the nation pays tribute on Labor Day to the people who created so much of this nation's strength, freedom, and leadership – the American worker.

Our second message is to remind you to Shop Union Supermarkets and Buy Union-Made products as you prepare for your Labor Day Celebrations.
